Literacy Night

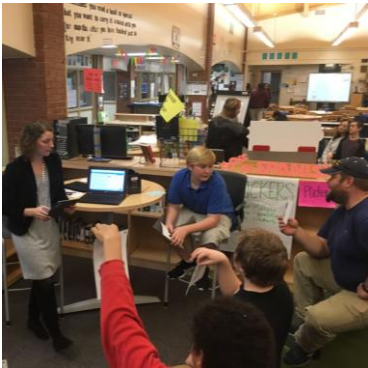
The ELA department presented Family Literacy Night, with dinner provided and a grade level competition using Literacy games.
